OWLS EVENT - APRIL 19, 2024: Deputy Laura Stahr of the Franklin County Sherriff's Office will be our guest speaker this month. While her primary duties involve teaching the D.A.R.E. program to fifth grade students in various elementary schools within Franklin County, she does provide safety talks on a variety of topics to all age groups. In 2008, she was one of four deputies who helped establish the Rape Aggression Defense Program at the Sheriff's Office. The R.A.D. Systems is an international program which is a women's only self-defense program.

Deputy Stahr will be presenting the Personal Safety Program. She will share risk reduction strategies for when you're at home, in your car or going through your daily routine. Three elements must be in place for any type of crime to occur. There is a victim, an assailant, and an opportunity. By learning these safety strategies, you will remove the opportunity for an assailant to make you their next victim. These basic tips and strategies can help reduce your odds of becoming a victim of a crime.

Deputy Stahr is not a stranger to St. John's. Laura and her two young daughters attended church here a few years ago. Mark your calendars to join us!
