<u>ST. JOHN'S HISTORY COLUMN</u>: An article in a newspaper found in the basement of the church stated:

May 12, 1889, was the day of the dedication. A special train brought 500 guests from Columbus. The speakers at the morning service were two former pastors of the congregation, Professor Emmanuel Schmidt and the Rev. I. A. Schulze. Both preached German sermons. The afternoon service was English. The preachers were Dr. M. Loy and Rev. J. Breck. At the evening service, Prof. F. W. Stellhorn preached a German sermon, and Prof. A. Pflueger delivered one in English. Special music for the day was provided by the Grove City Band, the choir of Grace Lutheran Church of Columbus, and the choir of St. John's Church.
