

Special Congregational Meeting

President Aaron Clark called the Special Congregational Meeting to order at 12:21 p.m. and opened with prayer.

President Clark read the motion aloud: "The congregational council moves for approval by the congregation to spend up to \$60,000 of secure the services of architectural, engineering and technical services to perform an in-depth analysis of the existing St. John's facilities. The analysis is to identify, prioritize and estimate cost for correction of known and unknown building problems."

The motion must be approved by 2/3 of the voting members present in order to pass.

Members had the opportunity to ask questions and speak to the motion.

Members submitted written ballots. The ballots were counted and the results were as follows: 86 YES votes and 2 NO votes. The motion passed.

The meeting ended at 12:49 p.m. following the members praying the Lord's Prayer together.
